Zoe Bilgeri (*1995 in Vienna) is an architect and artist based in Zurich. She studied at the Technical University of Vienna, EPFL Lausanne, Bauhaus University Weimar, and the Estonian Academy of Arts in Tallinn. Her practice focuses on understanding and reinterpreting the narratives embedded in the built environment. By reassembling forgotten and discarded fragments, Bilgeri creates continuities within the remnants of the past. In her work, materials become storytellers, and architecture transforms into a medium that renders time and memory tangible.
